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remarkably removed from the devotional certifying and celebratory view of the south that has dominated books of this genre the southern state of mind addresses the question of whether inherited southern values problems and contradictions have survived the onslaught of modernization book jacket

naseem badiey examines the local dynamics of the emerging capital city of juba southern sudan during the historically pivotal transition period following the 2005 comprehensive peace agreement cpa focusing on the intersections of land tenure reform and urban development she challenges the dominant paradigm of post conflict reconstruction and re conceptualizes state building as a social process underpinned by negotiation badiey explores local resistance to reconstruction programmes debates over the interpretation of peace settlements and competing claims to land and resources not as problems to be solved through interventions but as negotiations of authority which are fundamental to shaping the character of the state while donors and aid agency officials anticipated clashes between the government of sudan and the sudan people s liberation movement splm following the cpa they did not foresee internal divisions that impeded reconstruction in southern sudan raising serious questions about the viability of an independent state in juba local elites interpreted the cpa in line with their economic and political interests using claims to land authority and political power to challenge the splm s agenda for urban reconstruction in revealing how local actors strategically interpreted the framework of land rights in southern sudan the book offers a basis for understanding the challenges that confront the nascent south sudan s state builders and their international partners in the future naseem badiey is assistant professor of international development and humanitarian action at california state university monterey bay

the south continues to be the most distinctive region in american politics over the last half century democratic dominance in the south has given way to the emergence of a truly competitive

two party system that leans republican in presidential elections in some ways the region is increasingly like the rest of the country yet even the degree of change and the speed with which it occurred give the south a distinctive air the contributors to southern political party activists examine both the development of american political party organizations and the changing political character of the south focusing on grassroots party activists those who are involved in party organizations at the county level john a clark is associate professor of political science at western michigan university charles l prysby is professor of political science at the university of north carolina at greensboro

when we read a history we believe ourselves to be reading cold hard facts of the events that took place and how they occurred but there is no real truthful way to know the approach our historian has taken with the historical sources this book deals with the uncertainty in writing history in the context of irish history in particular regan argues in this book that the notion of elision simply ignoring unhelpful evidence threatens irish history today regan believes that some historians have ignored unhelpful facts that perhaps do not further their point or perhaps contradict them altogether each chapter focuses on a period of irish history that regan believes to be inconsistent or incomplete in its facts he asks the controversial questions about the period of history such as why do some historians deny or marginalise the british threat of war and re conquest in 1922 why do so many irish historians describe michael collins as a constitutionalist or a democrat when the evidence argues otherwise was the irish civil war really fought between democrats defending the state against dictators attempting its overthrow did the new state briefly experience a military dictatorship under collins in 1922 thinking historically is not about learning history or accepting the past as it is presented to us it is as regan argues in his thought provoking work about developing the critical skills to interpret history for ourselves

one important tradition in political science conceives of the civil war in the united states serving as the functional equivalent of the english and french revolutions bringing with it the victory of liberal democratic industrialism over aristocratic agriculturalism from this

perspective the civil war is notable for its impact on the american state surprisingly however little attention has been paid to the distinguishing features of this historic rupture in american politics through primary source research and the re analysis of the rich historical literature about the antebellum era and the causes of the civil war lawrence a anderson explores the relationship between federalism and the movement for secession in the united states during the pre civil war era focusing primarily on south carolina anderson carefully revisits theory on institutional analysis of political development to expose what caused secession in the united states

you re in the american south now a proud region with a distinctive history and culture a place that echoes with names like thomas jefferson and robert e lee scarlett o hara and uncle remus martin luther king and william faulkner billy graham mahalia jackson muhammad ali elvis presley home of the country blues and country music bluegrass and dixieland jazz gospel music and rock and roll where menus offer both down home biscuits and gravy and uptown shrimp and grits where churches preach against cigarettes whiskey and wild wild women all southern products and where american football is a religion for more than thirty years john shelton reed has been minding the south watching over it providing commentary upon it he is the author or editor of thirteen books about the south and despite his disclaimer regarding formal study of southern history reed has read widely and in depth about the south his primary focus is upon southerners present day culture and consciousness but he knows that one must approach the south historically in order to understand the place and its people why is the south so different from the rest of the country rupert vance reed s predecessor in sociology at chapel hill once observed that the very existence of the south is a triumph of history over geography and economics the south has resisted being assimilated by the larger united states and has kept a personality that is distinctly its own that is why reed celebrates the south his essays cover everything from great thinkers about the south eugene d genovese c vann woodward m e bradford to the uniqueness of a region that was once a hotbed of racism but has recently attracted hundreds of thousands of blacks transplanted from the north there are even a few chapters about southerners who have devoted their talents to different subjects altogether from politics or soft drinks to rock and roll or the design of silver jewelry reed writes with wit and southern charm never afraid to speak his mind even when it comes to taking his beloved south to task while readers may not share all his opinions most will agree that john shelton reed is one of the best south watchers there is

a timely collection of essays examining the controversy surrounding the use display of confederate symbols in the modern south

from 1845 to 1865 the gulf of mexico was at the center of american expansion and southern imperialism a continuous state of war tells the story of several communities such as galveston new orleans and pensacola as well as countries such as mexico and cuba to uncover the way that wars within the upper rim of the gulf of mexico facilitated american and southern attempts to conquer latin american nations in the push for westward expansion that preceded the civil war white southerners along with other americans engaged in violent conquest in latin america and the american west through the wars that are chronicled here white southern concepts of race became more rigidly fixed maria angela diaz covers several conflicts leading up to the civil war with mexicans cubans and native americans she places the civil war within this framework and follows the trajectory of relations with latin america through the end of the civil war and ex confederates attempts to emigrate abroad gulf coast communities facilitated both the physical efforts to seize territory and the construction of the highly racialized imperialist ideas that reimagined latin america as a region that could secure the south s future yet the pursuit of that territory created a fluctuating and uncertain situation that shaped the choices of the diverse peoples who lived along the upper rim of the gulf of mexico in ways they did not expect

here is history in the grand manner a powerful narrative peopled with dozens of memorable portraits telling this important story with skill and relish freehling highlights all the key moments on the road to war he shows in particular how the election of abraham lincoln sparked a political crisis and that at this moment the extreme fringe in the south took charge first in south carolina and mississippi but then throughout the lower south sounding the drum roll for secession indeed this is the first book to fully document how this decided minority of southern

hotspurs aided by a series of fortuitous events drove the south out of the union

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
